

The Men of Genesis

Noah 2

Read Genesis 6 - 8

Context: *The flood is over and man has survived through one named Noah.*

What is a covenant? Who starts one? Who seals it? Who benefits from a covenant? Who/What is the new covenant? Read Jeremiah 31: 31-34 and Heb 8: 8-13 & 9: 11-15 & 10: 1-18. What or to whom did the old covenant point?

Consequences: *Why do we need a covenant from God? Why is Christ “better”?*

How was all of creation saved through Noah? What didn't God do? Why?

God's faithfulness: *What God does say to Noah regarding his family (Gen 6:18; 7:1)? Read Acts 11:1 - 18 - what does this tell us about God's faithfulness in families? What about creation...is it to be redeemed too?*

Our Response: *How we respond to His goodness...*

How are we to engage the lost, the culture and all of creation? Historically, what has the church done in this regard? Should we build “islands of Christianity” (Christian theme parks; Christian recording studios, etc) or invade those of our culture?

Prayer:

Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal where you should be more active in the culture. Ask Him to teach us respond to His goodness and ultimate salvation and how we're called to be salt and light where the lost are and allow them into our church so as to hear the Good News. Finally, pray that God would put ONE family in your life to invite to church.
