

## The Men of Genesis

Joseph 3

Read Genesis 45

*Context: After being accused of attacking Potiphar's wife, he is sent to jail and again, gains favor with the leaders. Then he interprets dreams of a baker and cupbearer, both in jail. Two years later Pharaoh has dreams that are strange and the baker and cupbearer tell him that Joseph can interpret them. He does and finds favor again with Pharaoh. (What were they?)*

*Then Joseph's brothers come to Egypt due to famine in Canaan and what happens? (See 43:26; 44:16...remember 37:8)*

*WHO OR WHAT IS THE ENTIRE BIBLE ABOUT?*

*Consequences: How did Joseph react? How did his brothers react? If the Bible was about us and "doing good" how would this translate? What would this story be about? Since it's not about us, how does this translate?*

*God's faithfulness: What the character of God? Who are we in this story? Who is Jesus? Is this a theme in the New Testament as well? Where?*

*Our Response: How we respond to His goodness...*

*Repent of trying so hard to "do good" so God will accept you and praise Him for accepting you unconditionally.*

*Prayer:*

*Take time for each of the cell group participants to praise Him for forgiving you in spite of all of us being the "other brothers".*
